Prêt Review: NUS Crowned #8 in World University Rankings

June 2024 - In the recent 2025
Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World
University Ranking, National University of
Singapore (NUS) retains its global
ranking of 8th place.¹ This puts NUS within
the top 1% of all Universities evaluated
this year, ranking amongst many highly
prestigious institutions worldwide. This is a
historic first for NUS to be placed in the
top 10 globally for the second
consecutive year. NUS is also the #1
University in South-East Asia.²

NUS now adopts a holistic approach when assessing applicants for admissions into their chosen degree programmes. This means that besides academic grades, other factors such as the students' interest, aptitude, and prior preparation, will be evaluated for admission. This holistic assessment now supplements the Aptitude-Based Admission of earlier years.³

The new holistic approach has an essay component which requires applicants to answer short response questions and list up to three achievements or nonacademic activities. The adapted process entails diverse essay prompts, probing applicants about their extracurricular activities, resilience in the face of failure, personal values, proudest achievements, and any additional information they wish to share. Applicants must also highlight up to three significant achievements, ranging from international accolades to community service, internships, leadership roles, entrepreneurship, and innovative contributions such as software development.4





NUS recently announced the holistic approach to admissions encompassing the student's interest, aptitude and prior preparation. Could you share with us more about what makes a potential candidate stand out in your evaluation process?

When evaluating potential candidates, NUS adopts a holistic approach that encompasses various aspects of a student's profile. Here are some factors that may make a candidate stand out:

Academic Achievements

Strong academic performance is usually one of the primary considerations. This includes factors like high school grades, standardized test scores (such as SAT or ACT), and the rigor of the courses taken.

Consistency in performance and a challenging academic curriculum can demonstrate a candidate's ability to excel in a university setting. As part of the NUS application, you will be required to answer 5 short-response questions. This is an opportu-

-nity for candidates to demonstrate their motivation, goals, and unique perspectives. A well-written, thoughtful, and concise response has the potential to set them apart and showcase their passion, aptitude, critical thinking skills, and suitability for the degree programme they are applying to.

Extracurricular Activities and Leadership

Participation in extracurricular activities, such as sports, clubs, community service, or leadership positions, can highlight a candidate's well-roundedness, time management skills, teamwork, and leadership abilities. We value candidates who have made significant contributions outside of the classroom. If the applicant has participated in activities like campus visits, attending information sessions, contacting admissions officers with thoughtful questions, or participating in universityspecific programs or initiatives, do include them in the application form as well.









Special Talents or Achievements

Exceptional talents, accomplishments, or recognition in areas such as music, arts, athletics, research, or entrepreneurship also makes a candidate stand out. These unique qualities showcase a candidate's dedication, passion, and potential for future success.

Letter of Recommendations

Strong letters of recommendation from teachers, mentors, or professionals who can speak to a candidate's character, academic abilities, and potential can significantly impact the evaluation process. These letters provide insight into the candidate's qualities that may not be evident from other parts of the application.

Nora, you received a Ministry of Education scholarship for international students. Could you tell us more about that, and what it means for you?


